

European Farm to Fork strategy

The Farm to Fork Strategy is at the heart of the European Green Deal ([A European Green Deal | European Commission \(europa.eu\)](#)) aiming to make food systems fair, healthy and environmentally-friendly.

The Farm to Fork Strategy aims to accelerate our transition to a sustainable food system that should:

- have a neutral or positive environmental impact
- help to mitigate climate change and adapt to its impacts
- reverse the loss of biodiversity
- ensure food security, nutrition and public health, making sure that everyone has access to sufficient, safe, nutritious, sustainable food
- preserve affordability of food while generating fairer economic returns, fostering competitiveness of the EU supply sector and promoting fair trade

The strategy sets out both regulatory and non-regulatory initiatives, with the common agricultural and fisheries policies as key tools to support a just transition.

A proposal for a legislative framework for sustainable food systems ([Legislative framework \(europa.eu\)](#)) will be put forward to support implementation of the strategy and development of sustainable food policy. Taking stock of learning from the COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission will also develop a contingency plan for ensuring food supply and food security [Ensuring global food supply and food security \(europa.eu\)](#) The EU will support the global transition ([International dimension \(europa.eu\)](#)) to sustainable agri-food systems through its trade policies and international cooperation instruments.

To enable and accelerate the transition to a fair, healthy and environmentally-friendly food system, advisory services ([FAS \(europa.eu\)](#)), financial instruments ([What's next? The InvestEU Programme \(2021-2027\) | European Commission \(archive-it.org\)](#)), but also research ([Horizon Europe \(europa.eu\)](#)) and innovation ([Home | EIP-AGRI \(europa.eu\)](#)) are instrumental as they can help resolve tensions, develop and test solutions, overcome barriers and uncover new market opportunities.
